#### 4.) AWARDS:

- Teams: Trophies to the top 6 teams in Developmental, JV, and Varsity Levels
  - Note that K-2 and 3-4 will be combined into one team category for scoring purposes.
- Individual Awards:
  - Top 30 places for Developmental K-2 will receive medals.
  - o Top 30 places for Dev 3-4, JV, and Varsity Races will receive medals
- <u>Award presentation</u>: Medals will be passed out at the finish line with <u>an impartial judge determining close races</u> (even if the chip says differently). Team awards and Individual Places will be announced shortly after races are complete as well.
- 5.) ENTRY FEE: \$2.50 per runner.

**10.) RACE ASSIGNMENTS**: Teams will be assigned to positions for which they will be responsible throughout the meet. These assignments will be sent in a separate email. Please let us know if your team will have trouble filling assignments.

## **IMPORTANT RACE DAY INSTRUCTIONS**

- > **SAFETY INFORMATION**: Youthtowne is a privately owned and operated facility that needs to be respected at all times.
- Teams and individuals may schedule a practice beforehand to preview the course. However, no one is permitted to be at Youthtowne on the property or the course without express advance permission from Youthtowne's Facilities Director. - > RACES WILL START EXACTLY ON TIME, ACCORDING TO THE SCHEDULE.
- ➤ HOME-SCHOOLED CHILDREN CAN RUN AS LONG AS THEY HAVE BEEN TRAINING AND COMPETING WITH THE SAME TEAM ALL SEASON. PUBLIC/PRIVATE SCHOOL RUNNERS ARE <u>NOT</u> ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE LEAGUE EVENT. CATHOLIC TEAMS LOCATED OUTSIDE OF THE DIOCESE ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE.
- ➤ ALL RUNNERS RUN SAME COURSE: Varsity and JV 1.74 mile Developmental 1.35 mile
- RUNNERS MUST BE ON THE STARTING LINE 5 MINUTES BEFORE THEIR SCHEDULED RACE.

#### > COACHES:

- PLEASE REQUEST THAT FAMILIES LEAVE AFTER THEIR CHILD'S RACE. WE HAVE LIMITED PARKING AVAILABLE.
- ENCOURAGE YOUR FAMILIES TO ALLOW EXTRA TIME TO GET TO THE EVENT. THERE MAY BE TRAFFIC CONGESTION.
- > SPECTATORS WILL BE RESTRICTED TO DESIGNATED AREAS AND WILL NOT BE PERMITTED ON THE COURSE. ONLY COACHES, ATHLETES, AND VOLUNTEERS ARE PERMITTED ON THE COURSE

- COURSE MARSHALS WILL MONITOR THE COURSE. PACING OF RACERS WILL NOT BE TOLERATED. ONLY ONE WARNING WILL BE GIVEN.
- MAPS WITH THE COURSE LAY-OUTS ARE ATTACHED.
- > IF YOU HAVE A TENT, PLAN TO ARRIVE EARLY TO SET UP. TENTS WILL SET UP ON THE SOCCER FIELD ADJACENT TO THE START LINE.
